

Camadex[®] vet Injection

Calcium, Magnesium and Dextrose

Composition : Each ml contains:

Calcium Gluconate BP	208 mg
Magnesium Hypophosphite USP	50 mg
Dextrose BP	200 mg
Chlorocresol BP (as preservative)	1 mg

Indications : Camadex Injection is indicated for effective control and treatment of the following disease:

- Milk fever (parturient paresis)
- Lactation tetany of mares
- Hypomagnesaemia
- Ketosis of ruminants
- Neonatal hypoglycemia
- as a supportive to anthelmintic

Dosage and Administration:

Camadex Injection is to be administered intravenously, sub-cutaneously or intra-peritoneal route. Before intra-venous injection it is desirable to warm the injectable solution to body temperature and should be administered very slowly.

Species	Dose
Cattle & Buffaloes	200-350 ml
Sheep & Goats	25-50 ml

Or, as prescribed by the registered veterinary doctor

Contra-Indication: This product is contraindicated in animal hypersensitive to any of the active ingredients.

Withdrawal Period: None.

Storage: Protect from light, store in a cool & dry place and keep out of reach of children.

Presentation: 100 ml, 200 ml & 500 ml bottle
